

Strengthening cybersecurity and compliance with Lochbox is as easy as sending a text, making a phone call, or joining a virtual meeting.

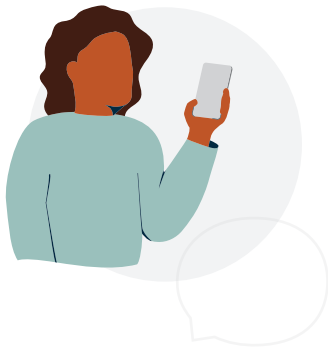
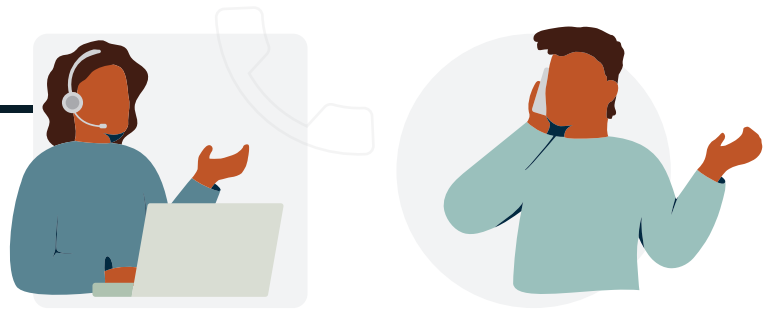
